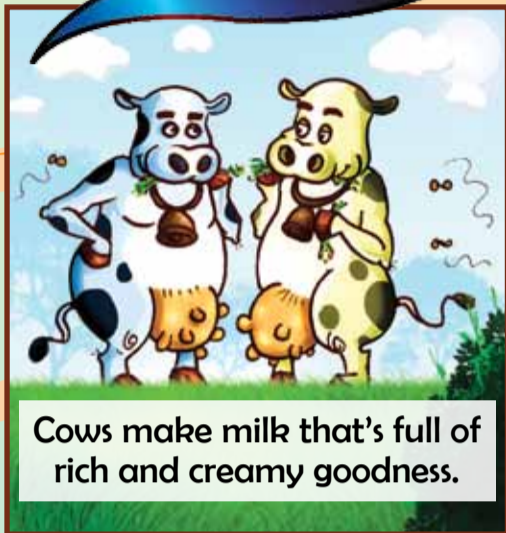
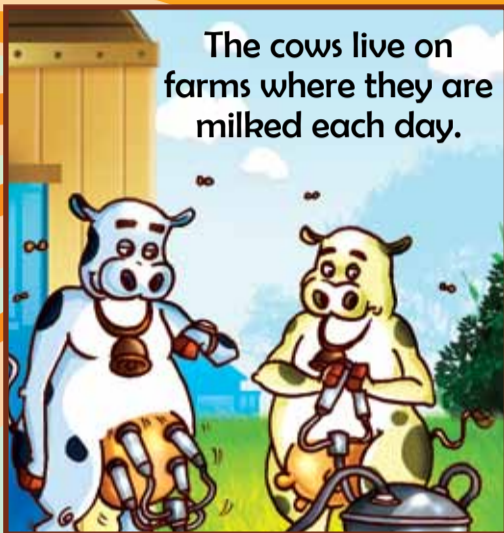


Milky goodness

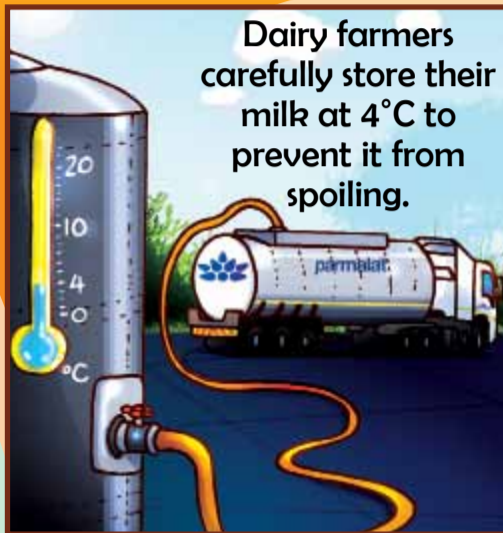
From the farm to your tummy



Cows make milk that's full of rich and creamy goodness.



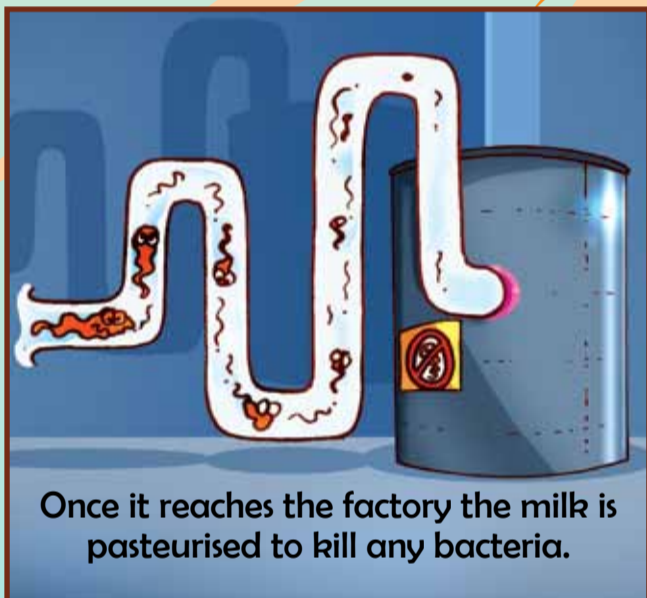
The cows live on farms where they are milked each day.



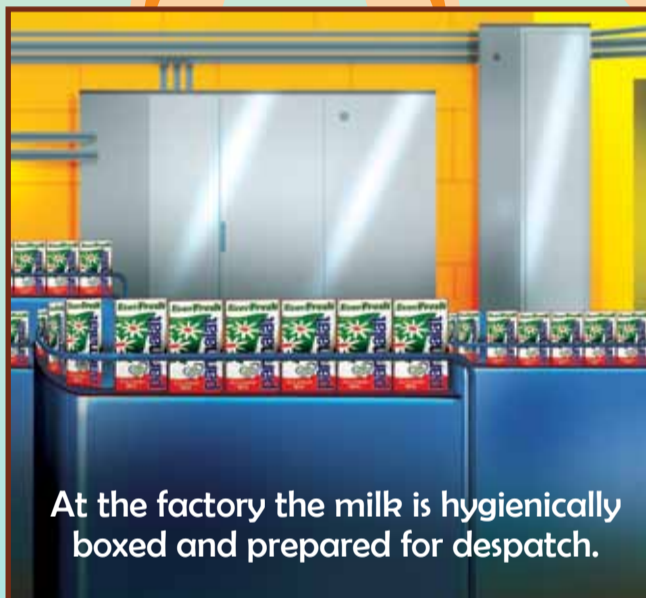
Dairy farmers carefully store their milk at 4°C to prevent it from spoiling.
